Supply Chain Risk Assessment

As a supplier of primary food packaging, we understand the importance of ensuring an uninterrupted supply. To that end, we are actively monitoring and assessing our own sources of supply on an ongoing basis. We have ample inventory and raw materials, and we are confident that there is a very low risk of interruption in our ability to continue to produce and supply food-safe packaging.

Preventative Measures

In accordance with maintaining good manufacturing practices, The Revere Group has communicated directly with all employees to review their health and safety as well as to instruct on best practices for avoiding illness. Additionally, we have implemented the following:

- We have initiated a remote-work situation, for all workers capable of doing so;
- Our employees will stay home if sick or go home if they begin to show symptoms correlating to flu or COVID-19 (fever, sore throat, running nose, coughing, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing), or have come in contact with someone exhibiting them;
- We communicate frequently to all workers about symptoms, and provide hand sanitizer and other antiseptic products throughout the facility;
- We actively sanitize and disinfect social areas such as the breakroom and conference rooms in addition to routine sanitizing of door handles, desk surfaces, light switches.

The above measures have helped our employees remain free from infection.
